

HOT 96.9/WBQT Boston
"\$96K 4-Play"
Official Contest Rules

These rules apply to HOT 96.9's \$96K 4-Play Contest ("Contest") conducted by Beasley Media Group, LLC d/b/a WBQT-FM/HOT 96.9 ("Station"). **In addition, the General Contest Rules posted at HOT969Boston.com apply to this Contest. If there is a conflict between the General Contest Rules and the Rules for this Contest, the Rules for this Contest shall control.**

1. HOW TO ENTER

- a. The Contest will begin Thursday, May 2, 2019 and end on Friday, August 2, 2019 or once ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000) has been awarded, whichever occurs first.
- b. To participate in the Contest and enter on-air, listen to the Station each weekday beginning on May 2, 2019 and ending on August 2, 2019 at the following approximate times for the announcement of the cue to call: 8:05 a.m. ET, 12:05p.m. ET and 5:05 p.m. ET. **Note the Contest will not be conducted on the following Station holidays: May 27, 2019, July 4, 2019 and July 5, 2019.** The cue to call will include the "4-Play," which consists of a scramble of songs. Upon hearing the cue to call, the designated number caller (as announced on-air at the time of the cue to call) to the Station contest line at 617-288-1969 will have the opportunity to win a Prize by correctly identifying the song titles and artists in the exact order they were aired in as part of the "4-Play," upon confirmation of eligibility. The Station will be the sole judge in determining whether or not the caller correctly identified the song titles and artists in the exact order they were aired in as part of the "4-Play." Station is not responsible for any failure of a caller to reach the Station contest line including but not limited to busy phone lines, misdirected calls, equipment breakdowns, or disconnections. Calls will only be accepted at the designated phone number. At the time of entrant's call, entrant will be required to provide all information requested including entrant's full name, complete address (including zip code), day and evening phone numbers and date of birth in order to be eligible to win. P.O. Boxes are not permitted. In the event that the selected caller is disconnected, incorrectly identifies the song titles and artists in the exact order they were aired in as part of the "4-Play," or is found to be ineligible, there will be no winner for that cue to call. There is no limit to the number of times a listener may attempt to call in to win, but a listener may be a winner only once.

- c. The Prize amount will begin at five hundred dollars (\$500) for the Contest's first cue to call. For every cue to call where the caller incorrectly identifies the song titles and artists in the exact order they were aired in as part of the "4-Play," the Prize amount will increase by five hundred dollars (\$500) for the following cue to call. Once a caller correctly identifies the song titles and artists in the exact order they were aired in as part of the "4-Play," the caller will win the prize amount announced at the time of the cue to call and the Prize amount will reset to five hundred dollars (\$500) for the next cue to call in the Contest.
- d. There may be up to a total of one hundred ninety-two (192) winners selected in the Contest.

2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS

- a. This Contest is open to all Station listeners who are 18 years of age or older as of the date of entry into the Contest, who are legal US residents and reside in Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island, except where prohibited by law. Winners must possess a valid, government-issued ID and show proof of residency to verify eligibility.

3. PRIZES

- a. Up to one hundred ninety-two (192) Prizes may be awarded. Each Prize consists of a company check issued in the name of the winner in the amount announced at the time of the cue to call, ranging from five hundred dollars (\$500) up to ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000).
- b. At no time will the aggregate amount of Prizes awarded exceed ninety-six thousand dollars (\$96,000).
- c. No check will be awarded, processed or mailed until winner has claimed the prize at the Station, presented all required documentation, and signed all required releases and tax forms. Checks will then be processed within approximately eight (8) weeks following confirmation of eligibility and completion of all requisite releases and IRS forms.
- d. Prizes or prize certificates must be claimed at the office of the Station located at 55 Morrissey Blvd, Boston MA 02125 Monday-Friday, during regular business hours of 9am-5pm. Prize or prize certificate must be claimed within thirty (30) days of winning. Failure to claim Prize by the specified time will result in forfeiture of the prize. It is the

winner's sole responsibility to claim the Prize or prize certificate within the timeline provided in these Official Rules.

4. SELECTION OF WINNERS

- a. Up to one hundred ninety-two (192) may be selected and notified on-air as described in Section 1.
- b. Odds of winning depend in part on the order and number of calls received.
- c. Entrants must listen to the Station but need not be present to win.
- d. If any initially-selected winner is later deemed ineligible to receive the Prize, the Station reserves the right (but is not obligated) to air one or more additional "cue to call" sounders at any time during the Contest to award the forfeited Prize.
- e. Decisions of Station management with respect to the Contest are final.

5. CONDITIONS

- a. The Station reserves the right to end any contest or amend these rules upon announcement on air and by publication at www.hot969boston.com.
- b. For website contests: By use of the Station's website and by entering this Contest, entrants agree to the Station's Terms of Service Agreement and to the use of Personal Information as stated in the Privacy Policy located at www.hot969boston.com.
- c. Copies of the written Contest rules and a list of all winners are available during regular business hours at the main studio of the Station, address, city, state, zip, or by sending a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Station.
